#### A. For Councilor report,

- 1, Katerina Leftheris (MEDI) and Susan Olesik (ANYL) have been elected to serve on the ACS Society Committee on Science (ComSci) for a 2025-2027 term.
- 2, Attached is the Strategy Cafe report. I'm not going to review this, it's for your information, and much of it is related to Council/Councilors and Committees, but there are elements related to industry, entrepreneurship, and the like. What is implemented is what matters next and SCHB should consider how it fits in. ACS 2025 committee assignments won't be made until the December BOD meeting, when the Chair is determined (and committee appointments made with ACS PRES 2025 Dorothy Phillips.)

(Previously, I circulated the summary from the SCHB February 2022 SPS and the various goals and strategies; the full report can be shared upon request. Maybe we should consider working on a few of the projects? I'm interested in the one on identifying the committees and other divisions that SCHB members are involved in. I don't see any time for this happening before January, but can at least start to plan.)

- B. For old business, please add 2023 SCHB councilor reimbursement (it was new business at a previous EC meeting, but then tabled.) I don't have any information on why it was denied, there's nothing in the EC minutes, but the SCHB website shows SCHB councilor reimbursement policy (attached.)
- C. For SCHB 2025 standing committee assignments, best practices is to use the language in the bylaws: Finance, Membership, Nomination, Program, and Public Relations/Communications, The EC can assign other duties and create ad hoc committees, e.g., Awards Committee, but the Nomination Committee can cover awards and elections as that involves reviewing the SCHB membership roster for viable candidates.
